To All Suppliers:

The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania defines a solicitation “Addendum” as an addition to or amendment of the original terms, conditions, specifications, or instructions of a procurement solicitation (e.g., Invitation for Bids or Request for Proposals).

List any and all changes:

1. Pricing. Mack has a price update in January and July. But they do have some amendments to the pricing throughout the year. Since we are working of cost plus this will change the twice a year on the contract. **Suppliers must hold pricing for the first year. Pricing will be able to be updated at renewal date and six months after renewal date.**
2. Pricing. How do you monitor the billed invoices to make sure that cost plus the percentage is being calculated correctly? **Copy of proper price book must be presented when order is received.**
3. Stock Orders. With this contract does the awarded bidder provide the District with all the OEM heavy duty parts that they normally stock. **Not required**
4. Stock Orders. What is the timeline for the delivery of stock orders to the districts? **Answered in Specifications 2. Deliveries**
5. Emergency Parts. What is the timeline on Emergency ordered parts? **Answered in Specifications 2. Deliveries**
6. Engines. Where do we bid for the new and remanufactured engines and if awarded do, we get the contract for all districts in the state? **Last line of bid sheet. Specifications 7. Method of Award**
7. Costars. Just making sure that if we decline to allow this, we are still eligible to be awarded a contract for the districts we are asking for? **CoStars is a voluntary program and does not affect award of contract.**
8. We have two Mack and Volvo dealerships under the [REDACTED] **Company name** ([REDACTED] **Business A** and [REDACTED] **Business B**).
If we wanted to bid for two districts that the [REDACTED] **Business A** locations would primary take care of and one district that the [REDACTED] **Business B** would primary take care of, do we have to submit separate bids, or can we submit all under the [REDACTED] **Company name**? **You could submit under your company name for both business locations.**
