How many users will you require?

We currently have approximately 100 users who access our system.

How much data do you anticipate downloading per year?

We are currently using 75TB of storage and anticipate 200TB needed for current and future needs.

Is this a Backwards or Go forward solution?

We are unsure of what the vendor is asking with this question, so we cannot provide a sufficient response.

Do you anticipate any stress on the network with downloading?

Yes

Will the vendor have access to state network?

This should be an entirely one-way service. The vendor should not need access to our network.

What features and functionalities are desired, such as: Investigate, Transcription, Redaction?

The DOC would like the ability to securely access files, but would prefer that the system not allow transcription or redaction of data to ensure integrity of the file upload.

From whom are you ingesting information?

We receive information from each State Correctional Institution (SCI) and various Bureaus throughout the Department of Corrections.

With whom are you sharing information?

Each SCI shares amongst itself, The Bureau of Community Corrections shares amongst itself, and all sites share with central office and VDI users who have permissions.
