ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Science Education and Research Center (SERC) at Temple University is a 7 story, 252,000 SF building to be constructed at 1835-1899 N. 12th Street, Philadelphia, PA 19122. The University is seeking qualified contractors and vendors to propose on selected packages of work for the construction of the SERC.

BP - 8A: Secondary Unit Substation

The Secondary Unit Substation Vendor/Manufacturer shall have a minimum of 15 years' experience manufacturing and delivering electrical equipment for similar type Construction Projects in a tight, urban, and academic environment. The Vendor/Manufacturer shall demonstrate past experience with manufacturing and delivering Substations for Lab Buildings of similar size and scope. The Vendor/Manufacturer shall have verifiable experience for at least six past projects of a similar nature being satisfactorily completed on schedule.

The Vendor/Manufacturer must be able to meet all project requirements including OCIP insurance as well as EOP requirements. The Vendor/Manufacturer shall demonstrate their ability to coordinate their work concurrently with the Concrete, Structural Steel, Sprayed Fireproofing, Exterior Wall, Roofing, MEP, and General Construction Contractors.

The Vendor/Manufacturer must be able to meet the requirements of a fast paced construction schedule and must demonstrate that they can commit the necessary manpower and equipment to ensure on time delivery. The Vendor/Manufacturer must display capability to work and coordinate with the Construction Manager and MEP Contractors to ensure a seamless delivery and installation of the Substation.

Release of BP - 8A: Secondary Unit Substation

The release of the Secondary Unit Substation bid proposal package is tentatively scheduled to occur no later than November 12, 2012 with proposals tentatively scheduled to be due December 7, 2012.
