SPECIFICATIONS FOR PA STATE POLICE DUTY WEAPONS (FIREARMS & ACCESSORIES)

CONTRACT SCOPE/OVERVIEW: The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of General Services (DGS) is issuing this Invitation for Bid (IFB) for Duty Weapons (Firearms and Accessories) for the PA State Police (PSP). The resulting contract will meet the needs of the PSP for duty weapons, training equipment and accessories.

This is a no substitute bid for the firearms and listed accessories; the only firearm that will be accepted for this bid is the Glock 21 Gen 4. The items listed under Training Equipment and Accessories are required.

CONTRACT QUANTITIES: Contract quantities include an initial order of 4800 Glock 21 Gen 4 firearms, with a contracted option to replenish as needed. Replenishment order quantities are estimated to total 500 for the initial term of the contract, which is two years. Individual replenishment orders will be an approximate quantity of 100 each. The requirements and quantities set forth in these specifications are for the firearms and all related accessories and services.

PRICING: Bidders must enter a per unit price for the Glock 21 Gen 4 firearms on Attachment A, Bid Sheet. This per unit price shall be for each new firearm as specified herein and is inclusive of all accessories listed and all required training and training materials. This per unit bid price will also be applied to the initial order and all replenishment orders for the initial term of the contract.

Additionally, on Attachment A, Bid Sheet, Bidders must enter a per unit trade-in price for the used firearms identified in the section titled Trade-in of Used Firearms of these Specifications. The spreadsheet will calculate the total Bid Price, total trade-in value and deduct the total trade-in value from the total bid price to determine the Final Bid Price. The completed Attachment A, Bid Sheet, should be attached to your bid.

METHOD OF AWARD: It is the intention of the Commonwealth to award to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. Lowest bid will be determined by deducting the total trade-in value from the total bid price for the new firearms, accessories and training and comparing the Final Bid Prices.

DELIVERY LOCATION: The firearms shall be delivered fully factory assembled and dutyready. The awarded bidder shall provide weapon serial numbers prior to shipment to the PSP contact person listed below. The firearms, all training, equipment, and accessories must be delivered 120 days after receipt of purchase order. The awarded supplier shall contact Steve McCutcheon at 717-705-5932 no less than seven calendar days prior to delivery in order to coordinate the delivery of the items.

TRAINING: Armorer training for 70 armorers on the new firearms shall be provided by the awarded Contractor at a time and location to be determined. Advanced armorer training for 8 armorers shall be provided by the awarded Contractor at a time and location to be determined. All training and training materials as set forth in this specification shall be included in the unit price of the firearms.

TRADE-IN OF USED FIREARMS: As part of this Invitation for Bid, PSP desires to trade in 4800 Glock Model 37 firearms, each with three clips and are equipped with Glock Night Sights front and rear. The firearms included in the trade-in are 0 to 6 years old and are in NRA good to very good condition.

For sixty (60) days following receipt of the used firearms by the Contractor; PSP Personnel shall have the opportunity to purchase, from that Contractor, a used PSP service firearm. Purchase shall be at trade-in price plus any fees imposed by law or by the Contractor for the proper transfer of the firearm to PSP Personnel. The awarded Contractor shall ensure that the sale of the firearm to the PSP Personnel complies with all applicable State and Federal laws. Following the sixty (60) day time frame, the awarded Contractor may sell or otherwise dispose of the firearms as provided by law.

FEDERAL LICENSE REQUIRED: All Bidders must be a Glock dealer/distributor authorized to sell to Pennsylvania law enforcement and must have a Federal Firearms License and a Pennsylvania Firearms License. A copy of their authorization to sell in Pennsylvania and copies of both the Federal and Pennsylvania Firearms Licenses shall be attached to the bid. If these documents are not included with the bid, the Department shall request the documents and, upon request, the bidder shall provide such within 3 business days.

PAYMENT: Payment shall be made upon satisfactory delivery of all merchandise and shall include the final itemized trade-in values.
