- 1. For the budget portion are you seeking a budget for the remaining 9 months of this contract year and then 4 separate budgets for the possible 4 renewal years or do you want it combined into one budget?
- (a) We are not asking for a budget at this time. Please bid \$1.00 as is listed on the Tendering Text on the bid. All responsive/responsible bidders will be issued a contract. We will then ask for quotes from all the vendors that were issued a contract. During the quote process is when budget will be addressed.
- 2. I didn't see a form to put Eligibility requirements, qualifications/experience on. Is it allowed to be submitted as a word document and if so is there any page limit? Also, is there a limit to attachments that can be sent such as job descriptions/resumes, etc.? The bid submission includes the signed bid form, signed Attachment F (Lobbying certification and disclosure), signed Attachment G (Domestic workforce Utilization certification form) and a narrative to determine eligibility (Section III, Eligibility Requirements). Are any other forms/documents required other than these at this time?

Required forms are the completed Lobbying Certificate, Domestic Workforce Utilization form, and documents to show eligibility.
