8. Would vendor's carrier need to bring it to the place you describe in questions 6-7?	Commonwealth personnel can locate the shredder as long as warranty will not be voided.
9. The specification for "automatic start/stop by photo cell" does not seem to exist for this category of conveyor fed shredder.	Yes, this will be acceptable.
