## WORKING CONDITIONS AND ENVIRONMENT

- 1. The people operating the incinerator must be vaccinated for rabies before operating the incinerator.
- 2. The incinerator is used for incineration of animals, animal parts and materials used to perform a Necropsy done as part of diagnostic procedure. A Necropsy is the dissecting of the animal's body as an Autopsy is performed on a person. After an animal is dissected, it is placed in a walk-in-cooler until it is removed and incinerated. When these parts are removed from the walk-in-cooler and placed in carts for incineration, a person will encounter some obnoxious odors and sights.
- 3. The incinerator is located just off the Necropsy floor. Work in the Necropsy Lab must continue and those working in this area will be exposed to the sights and odors associated with a normal Necropsy, including the handling and removal of animal carcasses, parts and internal organs.
