The Pennsylvania Game Commission is soliciting bids for the construction of a new Pole Storage Building on State Game Lands #258. The scope of the project includes the construction of a 40' x 80' x 14' pole building, framing, installation of metal siding and roof panels, concrete floor, lighting and electric, connections to existing electrical panel and new service to building, installation of garage and man doors and other building appurtenances. Bids will be opened electronically and read in the Division of Contracts and Procurement, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797, on **Friday, May 10, 2019 at 2:00 PM.**

When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents-----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.

SITE INSPECTION:

The PGC will conduct an optional one-time-only tour of the work site for prospective bidders on **Thursday, May 01, 2019, at 10:00 AM.** Attendees will meet at the building site located @ 90 old Trail Road, Liverpool, PA 17078. **PGC recommends potential bidders to visit the project site location.**

Enclosed are the Project and Conditions for Construction Contracts and Technical Specifications (Sections 1 through 12). Three drawings are also enclosed entitled "State Game Lands #258, Liverpool Township, Perry County". All bids must be submitted electronically using the SRM system.

Bids must be submitted before the deadline of 2:00 PM on May 10, 2019 to be eligible for consideration.

The Commonwealth reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technical defects in bids and to accept or reject any part of the bid deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided by law, award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. A Purchase Order will be generated at the time of award without further input from the

successful bidder. Awarded vendor will be sent a copy of this document and no work will be authorized until the vendor is in receipt of the Purchase Order.

All vendors who conduct business with the Pennsylvania Game Commission must have a Vendor No. assigned to them in order to receive payment from the Commonwealth.
