1. Who owns the responsibility of the routing? PDA or the Vendor?

PDA feels that moving forward the vendor/contractor should own the route as far as collection. Customer information will be provided (address/phone numbers/weight etc.)

2. When will the deadline be for pickups/route information?

July 1st - Sept 30, possibly as late as October if necessary

PDA would need the routes 3 weeks in advance so PDA's field inspector has a chance to run the route to double check that no customers are being missed.

3. When will the vendor/contractor get the list of farms to plan the routes?

Farms have until March to notify PDA, PDA will send the lists to the vendor/contractor by April 15th.

HHW events are conducted on the weekends and arranged with DEP.

HHW events are not restricted to just the counties that are participating in Chemsweep that year.

4. What is current pricing?

\$1.40 lb. for HHW

\$1.50 lb. for Chemsweep

5. How many HHW events were there last year?

8 events - 8-12 events is the average

The number of cars average 200-1,100 can be dependent on the weather.

The county recycling coordinators know their areas and work to accommodate.

6. How many farms made up the 77,415 lbs. collected?

In agricultural counties, 70% farms 30% homeowners

7. Is the county rotation list available? Yes the list can be provided. It is also on the Chemsweep website.

8. Do the regional offices still have storage lockers? Yes all but Region 2. PDA maintains an inventory of each lockers' contents.
