BOARD OF PROBATION AND PAROLE

PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT CONSENT FORM

[Provider's Name] in conjunction with the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole administers a psychological assessment for the Parole Agent position. The purpose of this pre-employment screening is to evaluate your psychological attributes and suitability to perform the essential functions of a Parole Agent. This evaluation consists of two phases: (1) standardized psychological tests and (2) an interview. Your interview with a licensed clinical psychologist will be tape recorded. Your participation in the assessment is voluntary and you may decline to participate or withdraw from the process at any time. However, this psychological assessment is a requirement for being hired by the Board of Probation and Parole.

A report summarizing the results of your psychological assessment will be submitted to the Personnel Division of the Board of Probation and Parole. A recommendation and the rationale regarding your suitability for hire as a Parole Agent will be submitted with the report. This report will be maintained in a separate confidential file and is the property of the Board of Probation and Parole. All data used to generate the report will be maintained by the [Provider's Name] in a secure file. Your data and/or report will not be released to you or any other parties unless authorized by the Board of Probation and Parole.
