The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) is soliciting electronic bids for improving 9.3-miles of road on State Game Lands (SGL) #71 and #99 in Huntingdon County. Bids will be publicly opened and read in the PGC Division of Contracts and Procurement, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797, on Wednesday, April 8, 2020 at 2:00 PM.

**When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents-----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.**

This is the phone number for the PGC South Central regional Office in Huntingdon. Dispatchers at the office will relay messages to Mr. Skipper.. Bidders should visit the site to ascertain the pertinent conditions such as access, site contours, proximity of utilities, road conditions and vegetation in the work area. An optional site tour has been scheduled for 10:00 AM on Monday, March 23, 2020. The tour will meet at access to SGL #99 along SR 829 (Hudson Street) between Saltillo and Three Springs. Location maps of the project area are included in the bid package.

The General Specifications package includes road work specifications and the prevailing wage determination. All bids must be submitted electronically using the SRM system. Bids must be received by 2:00PM on April 8, 2020. A bid guarantee or bond is not required.

The Commonwealth reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technical defects in bids and to accept or reject any part of the bid deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided by law, award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder. A Purchase Order will be generated at the time of award without further input from the successful bidder. Awarded vendor will be sent a copy of this document and no work will be authorized until the vendor is in receipt of the Purchase Order.

All vendors who conduct business with the Pennsylvania Game Commission must have a Vendor No. assigned to them in order to receive payment from the Commonwealth.
