The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) is soliciting electronic bids for construction of a shooting range on State Game Lands (SGL) #255. The scope of the project includes cut and fill earthwork to construct embankments, placement of stone on the range backstop, target line and shooting line, installation of steel target uprights, installation of chain link fence and site stabilization. Bids will be publicly opened and read in the Division of Contracts and Procurement, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797, on Wednesday, April 22, 2020 at 2:00 PM.

When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents-----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.

Questions concerning project specifications and requirements should be directed to Foster Schaffer at 717-787-9620. Any questions concerning completion of an electronic bid should be directed to the PGC Procurements Division at 717-787-6594.

Bidders should visit the site to ascertain the pertinent conditions such as existing site conditions, drainage patterns, vegetation in the work area and other working conditions. Contact Eric Erdman, PGC North Central Region Group 4 Land Manager at 570-398-4744 to get directions and site information. This is the phone number for the Game Commission's regional office in Antes Fort. The dispatchers at the regional office will relay messages to Mr. Erdman. You may also contact Steve Sneath, PGC Clinton County Foreman, at 570-962-3051. This phone number is for the PGC Clinton County maintenance building at the site. The personnel that operate out of this building are frequently in the field; please leave a message and your call will be returned. The project area is open to public travel. Permission is not required to visit the site.

Attached to the project listing in electronic format are Terms and Conditions of Project, Conditions for Construction Contracts and Technical Specifications (Sections 1 through 10). Two drawings titled "Law Enforcement Shooting Range" are also attached. All bids must be submitted electronically using the SRM system and must be submitted by 2:00PM on April 22, 2020. A bid guarantee or bond is not required.

The Commonwealth reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technical defects in bids and to accept or reject any part of the bid deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided by law, award will be made to the lowest

responsible and responsive bidder, and all bidders will be advised of the bid results. A Purchase Order will be generated at the time of award without further input from the successful bidder. Awarded vendor will be sent a copy of this document and no work will be authorized until the vendor is in receipt of the Purchase Order.

All vendors who conduct business with the Pennsylvania Game Commission must have a Vendor No. assigned to them in order to receive payment from the Commonwealth.
