The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) is soliciting electronic bids for the Scrub Oak Road Improvement Project on State Game Lands (SGL) #48 in Londonberry and Cumberland Valley Townships, Bedford County. The scope of the project includes improvements to the roadway corridor and road surface and related improvements. Bids will be publicly opened and read in the Division of Contracts and Procurement, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797, on **Wednesday, April 29, 2020 at 2:00 PM.**

When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents-----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.

Bidders should visit the site to ascertain the pertinent conditions such as access, site contours, proximity of utilities and existing structures and vegetation in the work area. The phone number listed is for the PGC Southcentral Regional Office in Huntingdon; dispatchers at the regional office will relay messages to Mr. Zuck.

There will be an optional site inspection tour held at 10:00 AM on Wednesday, April 22, 2020. Interested Bidders should meet at the intersection of Paradise Road and US 220.

Attached to the project listing in electronic format are Terms and Conditions of Project, Conditions for Construction Contracts and Technical Specifications (Sections 1 through 7). Three (3) drawings titled “Hunter Access Parking Improvements” are also attached. These documents are all part of the electronic proposal. All bids must be submitted electronically using the SRM system and must be submitted by **Wednesday, April 29, 2020 at 2:00 PM.** A bid guarantee or bond is not required.

The Commonwealth reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to waive technical defects in bids and to accept or reject any part of the bid deemed in the best interests of the Commonwealth. Except as otherwise provided by law, award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, and all bidders will be advised of the bid results. A Purchase Order will be generated at the time of award without further input from the successful bidder. Awarded vendor will be sent a copy of this document and no work will be authorized until the vendor is in receipt of the Purchase Order.

All vendors who conduct business with the Pennsylvania Game Commission must have a Vendor No. assigned to them in order to receive payment from the Commonwealth.
