The Commonwealth of Pennsylvania defines a "Addendum" as an addition to or amendment of the original terms, conditions, specifications, or instructions of a procurement solicitation (e.g., Invitation for Bids or Request for Proposals).

List any and all changes:

Question: Due to the volubility of the supply of liquid asphalt cement incorporated into bituminous concrete pavement most projects that have a significant amount of paving will include an "Asphalt Escalation Clause" which ties the bid price of the asphalt to the PAPA Monthly Index. This protects both the Customer and the Contractor from unforeseen swings in the price of crude oil. Please consider including an asphalt escalation clause as part of this bid package (for instance – PennDOT's escalation clause in the Pub 408).

Answer: The cost for bituminous materials will be adjusted based on the price index published by the Pennsylvania Asphalt Pavement Association (PAPA). The adjustment is based on the ratio of the price index for the month the material was placed (IP) and the price index included in the bid (IB). The value of the price adjustment will be calculated using Price Adjustment of Bituminous Material form attached to this addendum.

WHEN THE RATIO IP/IB FALLS WITHIN THE RANGE OF 0.90 TO 1.10 NO PRICE ADJUSTMENT IS NEEDED

WHEN THE RATIO IP/IB IS CALCULATED TO BE LESS THAN 0.90, THE DEPT. WILL RECEIVE A PRICE REBATE

WHEN THE RATIO IP/IB IS CALCULATED TO BE GREATER THAN 1.10, THE CONTRACTOR WILL RECEIVE A PRICE INCREASE

The price index in the bid (IB) that will be used to calculate a price adjustments for bituminous materials will be based on the June price index: 416.0
