Please note you are bidding a percentage plus or minus from the Medical Assistance Fee for Service Rates. Please notes on each line to clarify how to bid on the line. There is not a list of tests.

7		Management has some concerns with some of the General SOW requirements (not so much the specific Warren State requirements). Can the SOW requirements ever be challenged/responded to? If so, how?	The requirements cannot be changed with an IFB, which is awarded at low cost.

8		Supplier bids should be bid \$1.00 each as the unit price on the line of serving facility. Please advise if below is what should be entered under the item tab for Warren. If we are bidding on Warren State, is \$1.00 what we would enter? I.e. \$1.00 on the pricing column?	Please see the notes on each line to clarify how to bid on the line. For purposes of the electronic submission, all responders should bid \$1.00 on this line as this is an estimated spend amount for MA rate services. Invoice prices will be based off the MA Rate Certification Form filled out.

10		Is there a way to add these to our submission response? We really don't have any issues with the Specific Warren State SOW- just the general SOW.	No, you cannot add additional requirements, including the time to report results. The Facility's Statement of Work takes precedent over the General Statement of Work. After award, a Facility will submit their detailed specific requirements to the Contractor which will become part of the awarded contract.

11		Regarding the requirements in the statement of Work: Vendor needs to be Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendment Certified (CLIA). Is it an issue if we are CAP certified, not CLIA?	The vendor must meet the requirements for certification under Medicare regulations (42CFR Part 493) and possess a valid PA DOH permit.

12		Regarding the requirements in the statement of Work: DHS will notify the Contractor in writing of any unsatisfactory services rendered and the Contractor shall correct the deficiency immediately after such notification. What do they consider immediate? I think that needs defined.	Depending on the circumstances, the Facility will determine what immediate is.

13		Regarding the requirements in the statement of Work: The Contractor shall also receive training from the Facility pertaining to procedures in dealing with the specific populations at a Facility. What training would be included? Can the facility be more specific? We would have to know what training, how long the training takes, and who needs trained?	The Department does not anticipate that this training will be extensive, and the Facility will specify in its Facility's specific Statement of Work.

15		Regarding the requirements in the statement of Work: Phlebotomists must wear personal protective equipment ("PPE") during the venipuncture and other collection procedures, including but not limited to gloves, which must be changed after each venipuncture and any other additional PPE required by Facility policy. This bullet does not indicate who is responsible for providing any "additional PPE required by Facility policy." If it is outside what we provide as our standard, is the Facility providing at their cost? This needs to be clear in the agreement.	If the additional PPE is standard in the industry, the Contractor is financially responsible.

16		If there is no listing for a reimbursement price for the CPT code for Medicaid or Medicare, what is the expectation for the charge for the test to the facility?	The Department does not anticipate a need for a laboratory test that does not have either a Medicare or Medicaid fee. If a Facility does require such a test, the Department will pay the selected Contractor a percentage off the selected Contractor's fee schedule. The selected Contractor must submit its fee schedule along with its invoice for any such tests lacking either a Medicare or Medicaid fee. Please provide the percentage to be deducted from your fee schedule for any such tests. This percentage will not be used to determine the lowest responsible bidder.
