Prospective Bidders:

The Northcentral Region of the Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) is soliciting bids for supply and delivery of agricultural lime in Elk, Cameron, Potter and Clinton Counties.

Bids are to be submitted electronically through the Commonwealth's "PA Supplier Portal" system by April 7, 2023. If you have not registered as a vendor with the state, you must first complete this at www.pasupplierportal.state.pa.us prior to submitting an electronic bid. Any questions regarding this may be directed to Bobbi Mercer (bmercerc@pa.gov) at 717-787-6594.

The bid shall be awarded on a *single contract basis*. The unit price shall include the cost of lime, hauling, labor, fuel, insurance, delivery and all miscellaneous expenses necessary for the completion of the tasks. Prices bid shall be in dollar and cents only. Payment will be dispersed based on the amount of work completed as per the required specifications. **The work may begin after the PO is received by the contractor and performance bond is provided to the PGC. Work must be completed before June 30, 2023. No extension of time will be awarded.**

GENERAL SPECIFICATIONS
Elk Range – Agricultural Lime Delivery

I. SCOPE OF WORK:

- A.** The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC), Northcentral Region, requires services to supply and deliver 621 tons of agricultural lime to 16 sites in Elk, Cameron, Potter and Clinton Counties. Services shall include, but not be limited to, the furnishing of all lime, hauling, labor, fuel, insurance, and delivery as per the specifications herein.

All Purchase Orders require the contractor to provide the lime, hauling, labor, fuel insurance, delivery, and all miscellaneous expenses to complete the requested service.

- B.** This project is being bid as one contract.

II. PROJECT LOCATIONS:

Delivery sites are located at 16 different locations on State Game Lands, State Forest lands and State Park lands. GPS coordinates for each delivery site are listed in Attachment 1. More detailed location maps of each site are attached at the end of this document.

III. CONTRACT TASKS:

- A.** The contractor will supply all lime, hauling, labor, fuel, insurance, and delivery to 16 different stockpile locations.
- B.** All deliveries will be coordinated with Game Lands Maintenance Worker Supervisor Gage Meyer who shall be contacted in advance of all deliveries to schedule the delivery and provide an escort to each delivery site as necessary. GLMWS Meyer shall be contacted by phone at least 72 hours prior to the first planned delivery at 814-787-5990 (office) or 223-231-8501 (mobile). Deliveries shall be received Monday-Thursday between the hours of 7:00am and 3:00pm.

IV. **CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS:**

- A. The project may begin any time after receipt of the fully executed Purchase Order. All deliveries must be received by June 30, 2023. No extensions will be granted.
- B. Bid Package Line Items:
 - 1. Delivery of Agricultural Lime – 621 tons
 - Bid per Ton
- C. The contractor agrees to comply with all attachments. The Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
- D. The contractor is obligated to furnish all lime, hauling, labor, fuel, insurance, and delivery as per the specifications herein. The contractor maintains responsibility for the entire project even if another organization/subcontractor is providing part of the equipment and/or personnel.
- E. Failure to comply with any of the terms or conditions of the Contract may result in cancellation of the agreement.
- F. The contractor is responsible for obtaining all township and/or state road bonding prior to any activity and shall maintain those bonds throughout the duration of activity.

V. **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

- A. The contractor will provide Worker's Compensation insurance sufficient to cover all of the employees of contractor working to fulfill this contract.
- B. Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, including bodily injury and property damage insurance, to protect the Commonwealth and the contractor from claims arising out of the performance of the contract. The amount of Bodily Injury Insurance shall not be less than \$300,000.00 for injury to or death of persons per occurrence. The amount of Property Damage Insurance shall not be less than \$300,000.00 per occurrence.

Such policies shall name the Commonwealth as an additional insured. Prior to the commencement of work under this contract, the contractor must provide the Commonwealth with current Certificates of Insurance. These Certificates shall contain a provision that coverage afforded under the policy shall not be canceled or changed until at least thirty (30) days prior written notice has been given to the Commonwealth.

HOLD HARMLESS: The contractor shall be responsible for and agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Commonwealth from and against damages to property or injuries (including death) to any persons and other losses, damages,

expenses, claims, demands, suits, and actions by any party against the Commonwealth.

VI. BID AWARD:

Bidders must offer prices for all items as listed in the electronic bid form.

The bid will be awarded to the bidder with the lowest total price for the entire project. One purchase order will be awarded for the project.

Bids are to be submitted electronically thru the Commonwealth's "PA Supplier Portal" supplier system by March 31, 2023. If you have not registered as a vendor with the state, you must first complete this at www.pasupplierportal.state.pa.us prior to submitting an electronic bid. The Commission reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to choose the bid that, in its sole opinion, best meet the needs of this project.

ALL VENDORS WHO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH THE PENNSYLVANIA GAME COMMISSION MUST HAVE A VENDOR NUMBER ASSIGNED TO THEM IN ORDER TO RECEIVE PAYMENT FROM THE COMMONWEALTH.

VII. CONTRACT TERM:

The contract term shall commence upon the contractor's receipt of the Purchase Order. All lime deliveries must be received by **June 30, 2023**. No extensions will be granted.

VIII. PAYMENT TERMS:

Payment shall be on a per ton basis for each of the 621 tons of agricultural lime properly delivered and received by the PGC as determined by a PGC representative. The price shall include all lime, hauling, labor, fuel, insurance, delivery, and all miscellaneous expenses to complete the requested service.

The contractor shall be paid on a reimbursement basis after inspection verifies work was successfully completed to the terms and specifications outlined in the contract.

Agricultural Lime Specifications

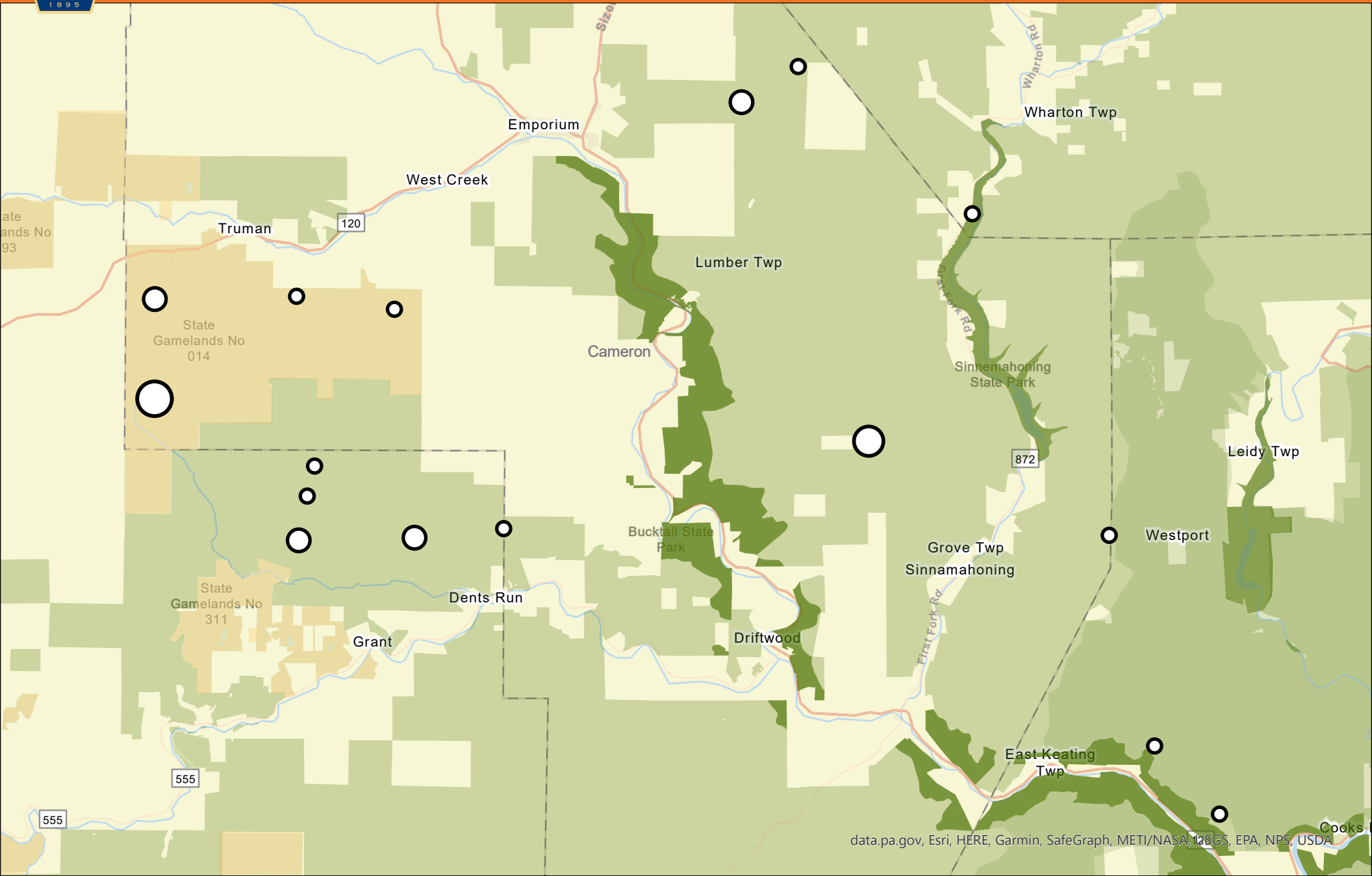
1. Aglime must be a ground, damp, calcium limestone product suitable for application with a spinner-type spreader.
2. Aglime must meet all of the following minimum standards:
 - Chemical Analysis – Calcium Carbonate Equivalent (C.C.E) of at least 80%
 - Screen Test – 90% through a 20-mesh sieve, 60% through a 60-mesh sieve, 50% through a 100-mesh sieve
 - Moisture – Less than 10% moisture content

SHIPPEN TOWNSHIP, CAMERON COUNTY



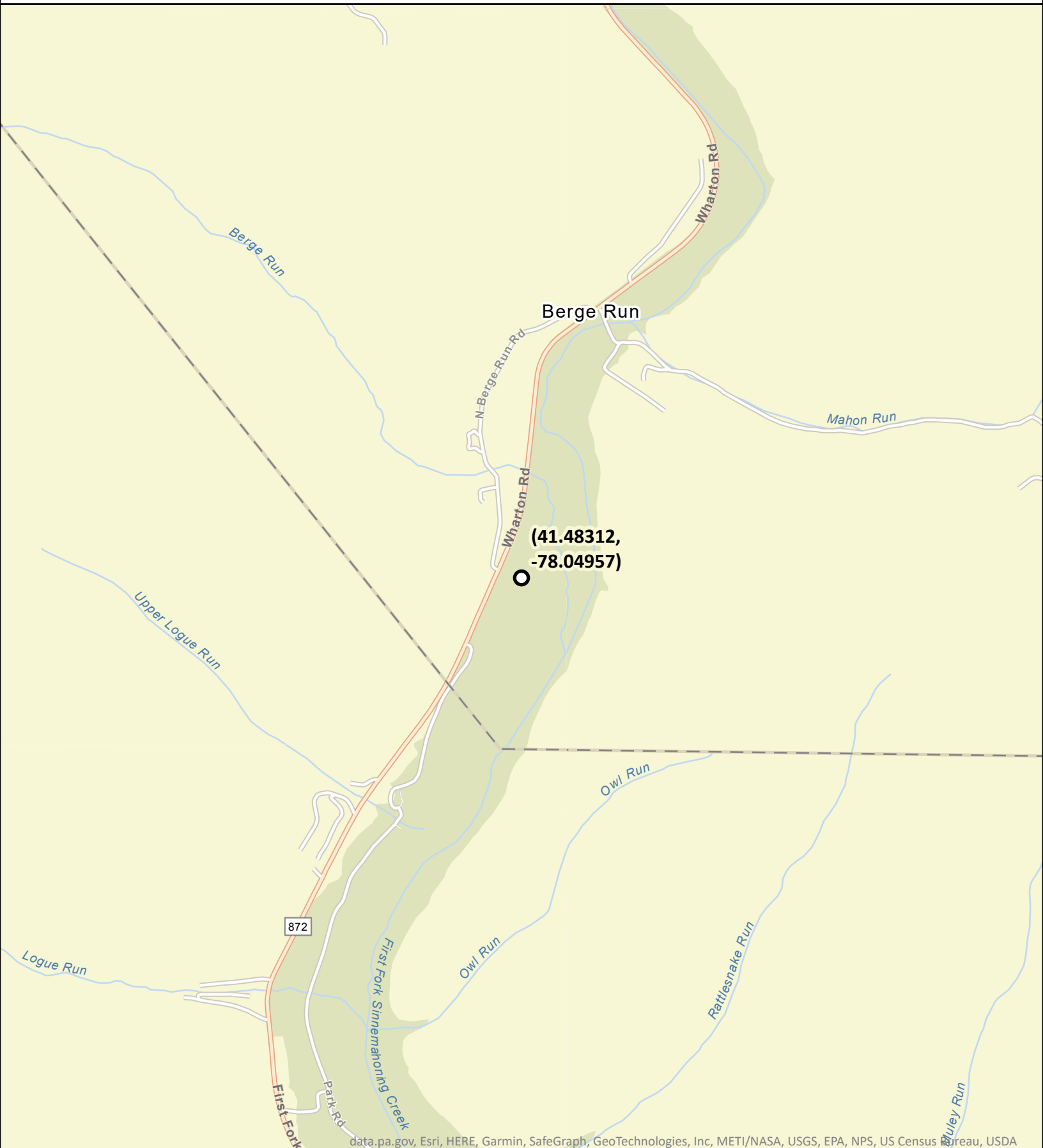
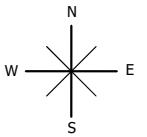

Loads of Lime: ○ 1 ○ 2 ○ 5 ----- Roads on Game Lands ■ State Forests ■ State Game Land



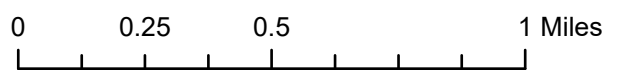

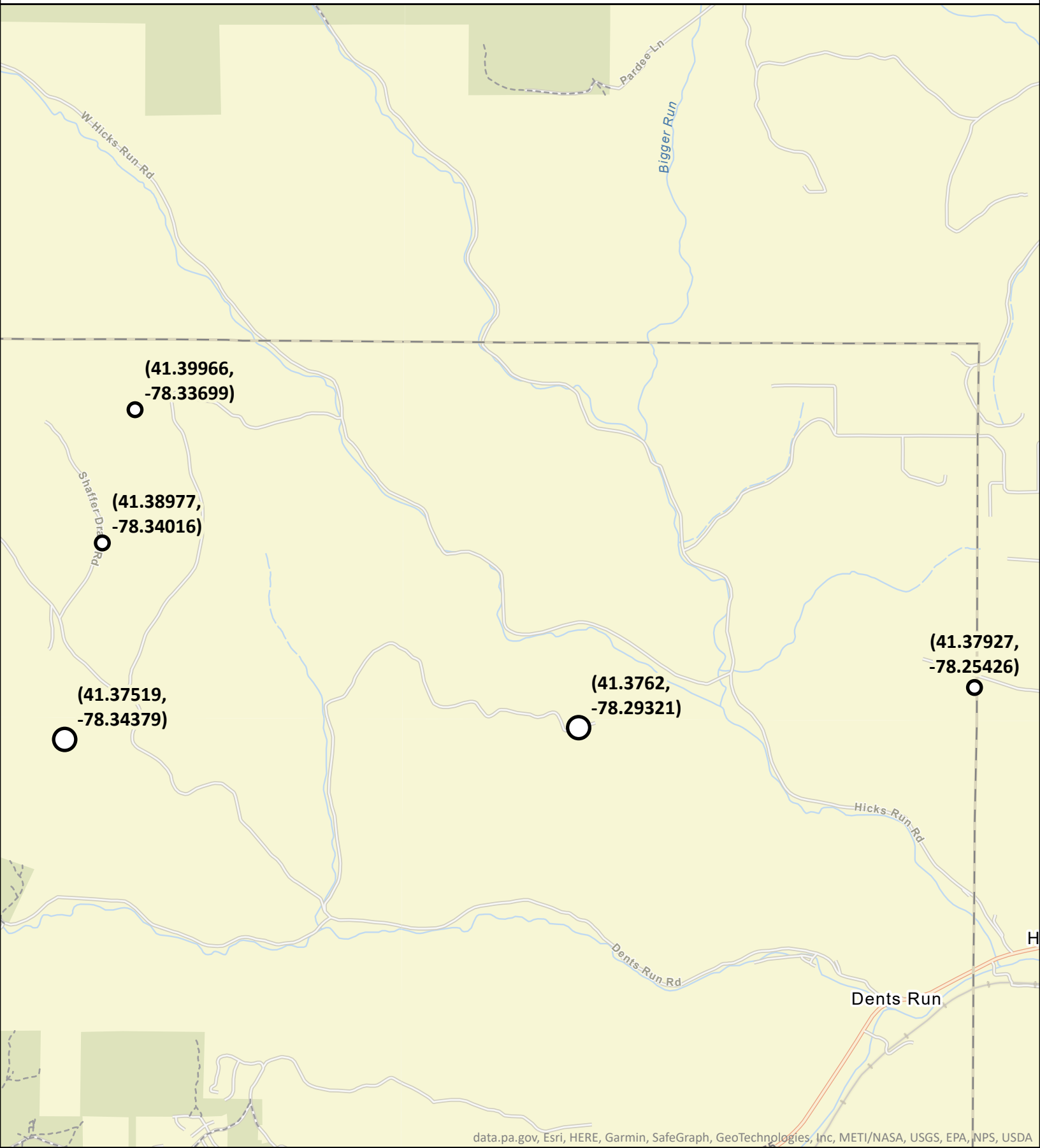
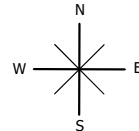
Loads of Lime: ○ 1 ○ 4
