Addendum Changes:

- 1) This addendum is to provide answers to all questions per the RFA Potential Applicant letter.

Q: I noticed that the RFA description includes traumatic brain injuries. If I'm not mistaken, I don't think that is part of the Spinal Cord Injury Research Grant Program.

A: No. Traumatic brain injury is not a part of the priority for this RFA. The description has been updated to remove this wording, as it was included in error.

Q: I am trying to download, RFP 67-115, "Spinal Cord Research and Grant Program" It says the file is incomplete on the bottom of this screen shot. I tried Explorer and Chrome. Can you send me the RFP & Budget?

A: No. The pdf file is located and available on the DGS eMarketplace site.

- 2) This addendum is to change the RFA as follows:

Change in who may apply –

Part One, A.3 Use of Funds, states "An institution shall apply for a minimum of one Grant only, in each of the three Tiers." The Department of Health is changing the number of applications that may be submitted by an institution. Each application shall have a different Principal Investigator. There is no longer a limit on the number of applications by institution as long as each has a different Principal Investigator.
