PARKING.

For this Pre-Bid Conference you should have obtained a temporary parking pass from Campus Police and parked in the Visitor Parking area in the last two rows in Parking Lot 'B' – Lot 29, the Parking Lot behind the Utility Plant. If you parked on Normal Street at a Parking Meter, you are okay as long as you feed the Borough parking meter. If you did not obtain a parking pass today, please see Mike Phillips for a temporary parking pass and move your vehicle to Lot 29.

There is a shortage of parking spaces on Campus. We have five to seven thousand people on Campus any given day and only twenty seven hundred parking spaces.

To park a private vehicle on the campus, it is necessary to obtain a parking permit from Campus Police and hunt for a parking place in the permit specified parking lot(s) like the rest of us.

Mike Phillips will arrange for a limited number of Contractor Company Vehicles (with markings) to park close to the Koehler Fieldhouse and Natatorium where the work is to be performed.

SITE CLEANLINESS. This is an operating Campus and appearance is important to our ability to sell our services. Therefore, we expect our contractors to help us keep the Campus reasonably neat and orderly. We have two special emphasis days a year; Spring commencement (May 15, 2015) and Winter commencement (December 12, 2014). These two days we expect our contractors to help us make an extra special effort to present the Campus at its best.

PROCUREMENT CODE and INTEREST PAYMENTS. In accordance with ACT 1998-57, the Commonwealth Procurement Code of November 1998, **Contractors must pay subcontractors within 14 days after receipt of progress payments from contracting bodies**, less sums held for deficiencies. There is a 15 day grace period, but, after that time, **the contractor shall pay INTEREST** on late payments in accordance with Commonwealth law.

BUILDING PERMITS. The Design Professional will submit the contract drawings to the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry (L&I) and obtain the required Building Permits. The University will pay any required Building Permit fees and related inspection fees. The Contractors will be responsible for coordination of all required inspections with the PA L&I assigned Building Inspector(s). The Contractors shall comply with the Uniform Construction Code (UCC).

SMALL DIVERSE BUSINESS (SDB) (MBE / WBE / VB AND / OR SDVB) REQUIREMENTS. Failure to comply fully with the SDB requirements as cited in the SDB Requirements Instructions will result in **your bid being determined as non-responsive and your bid will be rejected.**

Timely and Proper SBD Solicitations. It is important that the person at your firm responsible for SBD solicitations be notified of the Project SBD requirements and start the SBD solicitation process as soon as possible but not later than 10 days before Bids are due.
