## RFP # PHIEA 20-01 Exchange Assister Services Addendum 6 - Questions & Answers

**1. Question** – Based on organizational and communication impacts resulting from COVID-19, would the Issuing Office consider extending the due date for proposal submission from May 15, 2020 to May 29, 2020?

<u>Answer</u> – After consideration, the Exchange Authority is extending the deadline for proposal submission to May 22, 2020 at 12:00 PM. The deadline for submitting questions is being extended to May 15, 2020 at 12:00 PM.

2. Question – Section III-2.B of the RFP states, "For each category, please identify the individual name(s) of who will be key personnel, meaning they will be retained for the duration of the contract (there must be at least one for each category below)." The tasks related to overseeing call handling functions and coordinating enrollment events are very interrelated. A single person managing this oversight and coordination would be more effective and result in a lower cost to the Commonwealth. Would the Issuing Office allow respondents to propose the same named resource for these roles?

<u>Answer</u> – The Commonwealth is allowing Respondent to use discretion on who should be named key personnel. If one individual can serve two or more roles satisfactorily, then Respondent can indicate as such in its proposal submission.
