Addendum Changes:

1. This addendum is to provide answers to all questions per the RFA Potential Applicant letter as amended by "Addendum 1".

- A. Do you have an estimate for how much DOH expects to award in grants through this effort?

Answer: The resulting Grant Agreements will award a max of \$300,000 for each selected applicant in each of the targeted counties.

- B. Are you funding one project in each of the three locations or more or less than that?

Answer: The goal is to fund one project in each of the three locations.

- C. Is this being funded by federal dollars or state funding?

Answer: Funding for the resulting Grant Agreements is provided by Federal funds.

- D. Overall, this project would be considered an educational project, correct? There is no funding for people to actually buy gun safe in their homes, is there? Or could this be an option based on how an applicant responds to the RFA?

Answer: Per the RFA, Section A. Information for Applicants states that funding is only to promote safe firearm storage by taking a public health approach using evidence-based methods to decrease unintentional deaths and injuries due to firearms.
