QUESTIONS

- 1. Are efforts to close the Selinsgrove Center still being made by Commonwealth lawmakers? There are no active plans to close Selinsgrove Center. There is a proposed HB 1650 that, if passed, would require ODP to develop a plan to close all centers in a 5-year period. This bill has not been debated or voted upon. For it to pass, it will need to be passed in the House of Representatives, Senate and by the Governor. This seems unlikely to occur in the near future.
- 2. If so, does the Commonwealth anticipate such measures would be passed, and in what time frame? **If HB 1650 would happen to be reintroduced this year, it could take several years to be voted on by the House of Representatives alone.**
- 3. In the event the Center is closed, does the Commonwealth anticipate making a prepayment in full on the subject EPC project? If the Selinsgrove Center were to close, the Commonwealth would still need to pay the outstanding debt either in a lump sum payment or on the established payment schedule.
