Basis for the Emergency Purchase**Threat to public health, welfare, or safety****Identify the Threat:**

The BOL Radiation Measurement section has 10 Gamma detectors that must be operational 24/7 for emergency response to any nuclear event and routine environmental monitoring around five nuclear power plants.

Provide a brief explanation of the need for the material and/or service:

For the last few months the gamma spectroscopy system has been experiencing problems and generating errors during sample analysis and not printing the data reports for the sample. OA IT and Department IT along with the vendor have been troubleshooting. On March 5th, the BOL gamma radiation system crashed and BOL was not able to analyze any samples. A team from IT department for Server support, network support, BOL IT staff worked together and with the help from the service engineer from MIRION Technologies by phone and got the gamma system back on line after working all week and weekend. It is still generating errors during sample analysis so next step will be the proposed repair and upgrades attached by the vendor.

It will be a public health and safety threat in case of nuclear emergency and routine environmental monitoring around five nuclear power plants.
