As a result of the significant amount of rainfall that occurred during the summer and early fall of 2018, the pavement and shoulder on the southbound side of SR 219 continue to slide creating a dangerous situation. County forces have attempted to repair the area, but the slope continues to move and is beyond their capability to repair. The southbound lane is now closed using temporary traffic signals.
