Identify the Threat: In March of 2020, the first case of COVID-19 was confirmed in Pennsylvania. As of June 14, 2021, a total of 1,208,683 cases of COVID-19 were reported in Pennsylvania and 27,457 deaths in Pennsylvania were attributed to COVID-19. This is a global pandemic that has seen mutations of the virus resulting in more infectious variants.

Provide a brief explanation of the need for the material and/or service:	Case investigation and contact tracing are core tenants of public health. With the COVID-19 virus, these activities are essential to prevent surges of illness and death, especially among our most vulnerable populations. As the virus continues to mutate and the long-term effectiveness of vaccines is unknown, case investigation and contact tracing are the first and strongest steps in halting disease progression in a population. Case investigation involves interviewing the person with COVID-19 to better understand: the risk factors that may have led to disease, type and onset of symptoms, workplace setting, and severity. Investigators also review laboratory data and other diagnostics submitted to the Pennsylvania Department of Health. Contact tracing is the outreach to exposed persons to alert them to the exposure and provide recommendations for seeking medical care or testing and instructions to quarantine. These actions stop further spread of the disease.
