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The Pennsylvania Medical Society (PAMED) is a state leader in the continuing education of physicians and medical providers. As the opioid epidemic continues to impact thousands of Pennsylvanians, it is vitally important that medical providers across the state have access to the most current and evidence-based opioid-related continuing medical education (CME). To that end, with input from subject matter experts, including the Pennsylvania Departments of Health and Drug and Alcohol Programs, PAMED created and currently hosts six opioid-related CME modules on their website. Medical providers and the general public are able to access these modules for continuing education purposes and state board licensing requirements. However, these modules are outdated and need to be updated to reflect current evidence based medical best-practice and the changing licensing environment. Moreover, these opioid-related CME modules are proprietary, with PAMED the sole owner responsible for their content and maintenance. Therefore, due to the proprietary nature of the CME modules, the necessary updates discussed above will need to be completed by PAMED and are ineligible for a competitive procurement environment.

Department of Health staff discussed the development history and proprietary nature of the opioid-related CME modules with PAMED during several conference calls. Calls occurred on 1/3/19, 1/31/19 and 3/21/2019. Additionally, the six opioid-related CME modules are maintained on PAMED's website.

Opioid-related continuing medical education is a necessary tool for combatting the opioid epidemic in Pennsylvania, which has deep roots in the misuse of prescription opioids. Additionally, state legislation (section 9.1 of Act 191 of 2014) mandates that state licensing boards require specific opioid-related CMEs for license approval. The proposed updates to the existing opioid-related CMEs would not only provide medical practitioners with the necessary training to apply for and renew board licensing, but it would also ensure all practitioners are equipped with the most current and evidence-based tools for safe and effective opioid prescribing. Without these updates, medical practitioners will have an increasingly difficult time completing the required CME for board licensing, impacting t

Yes, timing is a factor. The federal funding for this project through the SOR grant needs to be by finalized and spent by September 29, 2019.

The efforts to update the opioid-related CME modules is a vital tool in the state's response to the opioid epidemic and consequently is a priority of the Department of Health and the Governor's Office.
