The Pennsylvania Game Commission (PGC) is soliciting electronic bids for mechanical and hand herbicide application. The project requires broadcast herbicide treatment of Japanese Stiltgrass, mile-a-minute and other invasive weeds. Services shall include, but not be limited to, the furnishing of all labor, superintendence, tools and equipment for the treatment of seedbed on approximately 94 acres of State Game Lands 252. Detailed specifications are attached in the bid packet. Bids will be opened electronically in the Division of Contracts and Procurement, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797, on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 at 2:00 PM.

When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents-----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.

Awarded vendor will be sent a copy of this document and no work will be authorized until the vendor is in receipt of the Purchase Order.

All vendors who conduct business with the Pennsylvania Game Commission must have a Vendor No. assigned to them in order to receive payment from the Commonwealth.
