List any and all changes:

This addendum is issued to address the following questions.

Question: Can you please confirm that the discount on parts is based on the OEM price list?

Answer: Yes, discount on parts is based on the OEM price list.

Question: Specific to Lot #4, Rolls-Royce M250 C47B Engines, please advise the average number

of hours flown annually, per aircraft?

Answer: 350.

Question: Specific to Lot #4, Rolls-Royce M250 C47B Engines, please advise average number of

cycles consumed annually, per aircraft?

Answer: 440.

Question: Specific to Lot #4, Rolls-Royce M250 C47B Engines, please advise if any or all engines

are "VIP" enhanced (CEB 72-6068 embodied)?

Answer: All engines are enhanced as stated above.

Question: Specific to Lot #4, Rolls-Royce M250 C47B Engines, please advise if any compressor

impellers are projected to be time or cycle expired within the duration of this contract?

Answer: No units are projected to expire within the duration of this contract.

Question: The cost matrix references 350 hours across all lots. Is this representative of an

anticipated 350 flight hours per aircraft?

Answer: Yes.

Question: For the Cessna C208EX, are these aircraft currently under an annual inspection program or progressive inspections?

Answer: Units are currently under an annual inspection program but may transition to progressive inspections.

Question: Please clarify training required throughout the bid specifications document. Are factory training courses from Textron, Gamin, etc. required?

Answer: Yes. At least one technician must maintain factory training requirements.

Question: Please clarify the schedule requirements referenced throughout the bid specifications document. Does "scheduled maintenance within 5 days of notification" mean the aircraft must be received by the Offeror within 5 days of notification?

Answer: Above language requires that it is placed on schedule within 5 days, not inducted.

Question: Will the customer provide access to the Offeror on their tracking system used to track flight hours logged? This could aid in avoiding scheduling conflicts for scheduled maintenance events.

Answer: No.

Question: Will the customer accept a team bid as long as one party in the Offeror's team is a certified Part 145 Repair Station.

Answer: No.
