Q1. Do you need to be the PA resident to submit the bid? [sic]

A1. The license transfer process will follow the directives found in sections 403, 404, 461 and 468 of the Liquor Code.

Pursuant to section 403 of the Liquor Code, if the applicant is a person they must be a citizen of the United States and a resident of this Commonwealth for at least two years immediately preceding the application. 47 P.S. § 4-403(b).

Additionally, If the applicant is a corporation, the application must show that the corporation was created under the laws of Pennsylvania or holds a certificate of authority to transact business in Pennsylvania, that all officers, directors and stockholders are citizens of the United States, and that the manager of restaurant is a citizen of the United States. 47 P.S. §4-403(c).

Q2. Is there any limit on how many county we can bid for? [sic]

A2. No, individuals can bid on multiple licenses. Please refer to the Bid Requirements section on page 3 of the IFB, the Bid Surety section on page 5 of the IFB, the Legal Specifications and Requirements section starting on page 7 of the IFB, as well as question 27 in the FAQ section.

Q3. Can you provide the total number of licenses by municipality across the state?
