

**DHS Data Analytics RFI Questions – October 21, 2015**

<p>Why is the anti-fraud RFI limited to data analytics and inclusive of other tools?</p>	<p>The Department welcomes suggestions on all tools that could assist with the goals outlined in the RFI.</p>
<p>Which systems, if any, currently in place will likely need to interface with the Data Analytics solution and which vendors provided those systems?</p>	<p>Systems may include, but are not limited to, PROMISE (Hewlett Packard), Fraud and Abuse Detection System (FADS – Hewlett Packard), Client Information System (eCIS – Deloitte), and DHS Data Warehouse.</p>
<p>Has any funding been allocated for the data analytics solution and if so, from where and how much? If not, where will DHS look for funding?</p>	<p>The Department has not allocated funding. The Department may seek federal enhanced funding in addition to state funding.</p>
<p>In the event DHS decides to procure, is there an estimated time frame available for when the solicitation might be issued?</p>	<p>The Department is unable to provide a response to this question at this time.</p>
<p>Is there a project manager, or technical contact in regard to this project and if so, can you please advise who?</p>	<p>The Department has not identified a project manager at this time.</p>
<p>If a vendor does not respond to the RFI, will they be precluded from bidding on an RFP if one is eventually issued?</p>	<p>No.</p>
<p>Do the prospective applicants for this RFI need to be a registered vendor with the Commonwealth of PA? If so can you direct me on how my company can become such a registered provider of services?</p>	<p>RFI respondents do not need to be a registered vendor. However, if a future procurement is issued, you will need to be a registered vendor.
