3.	<p>In Attachment A, it states that subcontracting is not permissible but in Attachment B, Section 15. It states "The Contractor may subcontract any portion of the Services or Supplies described in this Contract to third parties selected by Contractor and approved in writing by the Commonwealth, whose approval shall not be unreasonably withheld."</p>	<p>The awarded ITQ contracts will be for software development only and will not permit subcontracting. Software as a Service and other cloud services are not included in the scope of this ITQ.</p>

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	<p>Will contractors ultimately be allowed to subcontract? Is this an agreement that would allow resellers?</p> <p>In Attachment A, it states "The purchase of hardware, software, and staff augmentation services are NOT PERMITTED under this contract."</p> <p>For clarification is Software as a Service (Saas) or other cloud services allowed?</p>	
4.	<p>As a small diverse business, we subcontract and make significant contributions to large prime contractors on large projects. Can we use those projects as qualifications for this contract?</p> <p>This ITQ RFI represents short-term ad-hoc project work opportunities. The RFI has a clause whereby the contractor is not to sub-contract any work activities. That clause reduces a large majority of small businesses from supporting this contract based on the inability to afford a bench of W2 skilled resources to perform the ad-hoc project work. Request a change to the RFI clause whereby the small business contractor is able to sub-contract work activities to another small business and/or independent 1099 consultants.</p>	<p>All submitted qualifications relevant to software development will be considered.</p> <p>The Commonwealth intends to award ITQ contracts to vendors able to perform agile development services.</p>
5.	<p>This is my first opportunity working with the Commonwealth of PA, so I wanted to ensure that Software as a Service (SaaS) were aligned with the scope. Understanding this will help us determine if we can move forward with responding to this RFI.</p>	<p>The awarded ITQ contracts will be for software development only and will not permit subcontracting. Software as a Service and other cloud services are not included in the scope of this ITQ.</p>
