Question: My questions about bid #6100064852 is how we need to submit. I assume it would need to go directly through a qualified dealer located in PA? We run a very successful program here in NYS doing the mini-bid system where the dealer supplying the chassis submits the bid with our equipment. I have cc'd this dealer contact who has Chevrolet and Stellantis (Ram) through their dealership Towanda Automotive and they are also registered with COSTARS. If that is the correct way we need to submit for this bid, I think we should be all set.

Answer: As a vehicle upfitter, you'll need to partner with a Pennsylvania-licensed dealer. The dealer must hold a valid Pennsylvania Dealer License and provide a Letter of Authorization or documentation confirming they are a franchised representative of the vehicle manufacturer being offered to the Commonwealth. Please also note that this solicitation is not eligible under the COSTARS program.

Type of Solicitation: Electronic Bid (SRM) - Review the Questions section of your solicitation response to ensure you have responded, as required, to any questions relevant to solicitation addenda issued subsequent to the initial advertisement of the solicitation opportunity.

Except as clarified and amended by this Addendum, the terms, conditions, specifications, and instructions of the solicitation and any previous solicitation addenda, remain as originally written.
