Question 1: I (Goodyear Tire) had received notification of the publication of a new bid for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, but in the text of the attachments it lists 6100053976 as the original bid, and the new publication 6100063239 as being a supplemental bid to the original.

I didn’t see any specific dates or anything listed in the attachments as far as a duration of the supplemental solicitation aside from a due date of 04-04 with a publication date of 03-21-2025

I know we had just processed an extension in our agreement with the Commonwealth, but do we need to complete a submission for this solicitation as well ?

Answer: IFB 6100063239 serves as a supplemental bid to the original bid 6100053976, for which Goodyear is already under contract (4400025716). This new bid, 6100063239, covers Non-Core Tires and applies to the remaining 1 year term of the original contract, 6100053976.
