State Police Horse Routine Care Schedule

Spring:

Vetera Gold^{xp}: Eastern, Western Encephalomyelitis, Tetanus, Rhinopneumonitis, Influenza and West Nile Virus

Potomavac and Rabies: Potomac Horse Fever and Rabies

Duramune: Lyme disease

Digital Coggins Test: Blood draw for Equine Infectious Anemia

Deworm: Double dose of Pyrantel Pamoate paste

**These procedures can be split into 2-3 appointments as it fits your schedule:

January could be your Coggins and Lyme vaccine (Health Certificates for Farm Show?)

February could be Vetera Gold and check teeth

March could be Potomac/Rabies and deworm

OR

January: Coggins and Lyme vaccine, check teeth

February: Vetera Gold, Potomac/Rabies and Deworm

** A separate appointment could be made to float teeth needed done in either scenario**

Summer:

Deworm: Plain Ivermectin paste at regular dose in July

Fall:

Booster Vaccines:

West Nile Virus, Rhino/Flu, Potomac Horse Fever, Lyme Disease

These are all separate vaccines, so you may make them into 2 visits

July: Deworming and Lyme vaccine, check teeth

August: West Nile Virus, Rhino/Flu and Potomac Horse Fever

The teeth Floats could be done at the fall visits if that is easier for all of you, or we can do 8 horses in the spring and 7 horses in the fall for a total of 15 per year

Late Fall: October/November

Deworm and fecal samples: Take fecal samples from stalls and Deworm all horses with either lvermectin/Praziquantel or Moxidectin/Praziquantel at regular dose (these rotate every other year in fall)
