

III. CONTRACT TASKS:

The proposed habitat work on State Game Lands requires a 367-acre pre-emergent spray treatment of Japanese Stiltgrass along roadways, wildlife openings, and drainage ditches located on State Game Lands 244, 195 and 320 in Jefferson County depicted in Attachments. Work must be completed by ATV/UTV with sprayer attachments or other applicable machines.

- **Line Item 1:** 170 acres of State Game Lands 244 are to be treated between February 19th, 2024, to March 31st, 2024. **No application is to be conducted in times with snow cover in proposed spray areas. (Determined by Forester and Wildlife Habitat Group Supervisor).**
 - Pre-Emergent application to proposed areas using a 36 oz./ acre of ProClipse (prodiamine).
- **Line Item 2:** 170 acres of State Game Lands 195 are to be treated between February 19th, 2024, to March 31st, 2024. **No application is to be conducted in times with snow cover in proposed spray areas. (Determined by Forester and Wildlife Habitat Group Supervisor).**
 - Pre-Emergent application to proposed areas using a 36 oz./ acre of ProClipse (prodiamine).
- **Line Item 2:** 27 acres of State Game Lands 320 are to be treated between February 19th, 2024, to March 31st, 2024. **No application is to be conducted in times with snow cover in proposed spray areas. (Determined by Forester and Wildlife Habitat Group Supervisor).**
 - Pre-Emergent application to proposed areas using a 36 oz./ acre of ProClipse (prodiamine).

IV. CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS:

- A. A Foliar treatment of Japanese Stiltgrass using a 36 oz./ acre of ProClipse (prodiamine) with a water carrier (as outlined) on State Game Lands, totaling approximately 367 acres (see Attachments) must be completed during the period of February 19th, 2024, to March 31st, 2024. **No application is to be conducted in times with snow cover in proposed spray areas. (Determined by Forester and Wildlife Habitat Group Supervisor).**
- B. The Contractor shall provide **proof of a current Commercial Pesticide License and Applicator Certification** issued by the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. Upon completion of the project, the contractor will furnish PGC a copy of the **Chemical Use Records Log**.
- C. The Contractor agrees to comply with all attachments. The Commission reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
