This Project will be a multi-prime project delivered pursuant to a multi-prime contract delivery structure. The Prime Contractors will include: General Construction, Mechanical-HVAC, Electrical, and Plumbing and Fire Protection, Low-Voltage-AV/IT/TelCo, and each other contractor engaged directly by Temple to perform construction or supply machinery, materials, equipment or labor for construction of the Project and which are identified by Temple as being a Prime Contractor for the Project.

## **Plumbing and Fire Protection Construction**

The Scope of Work for the Plumbing and Fire Protection Construction Package shall include all necessary services, Work, labor, materials, supervision, tools, supplies, equipment, insurance, and applicable taxes necessary to complete Plumbing and Fire Protection Construction Package as shown in the Contract Documents for the above referenced Project.
