Q: Is an appointment needed to visit the site?

A: An appointment is not required to visit the site. The technical point of contact should be notified to accompany you as some of the waste tires are on a hillside and not in plain view from the roadway.

Q: Is there room to set a shredder on site?

A: Room for a shredder should be determined by the bidding entity. This can be determined based on a site visit.

Q: Will soil samples be required and/or submitted?

A: Soil samples are <u>not</u> required for this cleanup.

Q: The pictures indicated there may be some tires around trees, can the trees be moved/removed?

A: Trees should not be cut down to remove one waste tire. Waste tires should be cut off of the trees.

Q: When is this project expected to be awarded? When is the PO expected to be issued? What are the estimated dates?

A: Award will be made to the lowest responsible responsive bidder. Award would occur after the scheduled bid closing and review of all offers. A fully executed Purchase Order would be issued to finalize the transaction. If an award is made, it would occur within 60 days of the bid opening date. The bid opening date is being extended with this addendum. A fully executed Purchase Order would follow the award, after all required approvals are received. This may take approximately 15-45 days. All timelines are subject to change.
