When bidding, amount bid should be in dollars and cents----no fractions of a cent will be accepted.

Mr. McNeal is frequently in the field with limited cell service; please leave a message and your call will be returned. The project area is not open to public travel because it is behind locked gates. We recommend contacting Mr. McNeal to make arrangements for unlocking the gate and for directions and status of road conditions before going to the site.

Attached to the project listing in electronic format are Terms and Conditions of Project, Conditions for Construction Contracts and Technical Specifications (Sections 1 through 3). One drawing titled "Seldom Seen Road – Surface Treatment Project" is also attached. All bids must be submitted electronically using the SRM system and must be submitted by 2:00PM on April 10, 2024. A bid guarantee or bond is not required.

Except as otherwise provided by law, award will be made to the lowest responsible and responsive bidder, and all bidders will be advised of the bid results.
